Ahhhh....I can clearly hear your second thought...

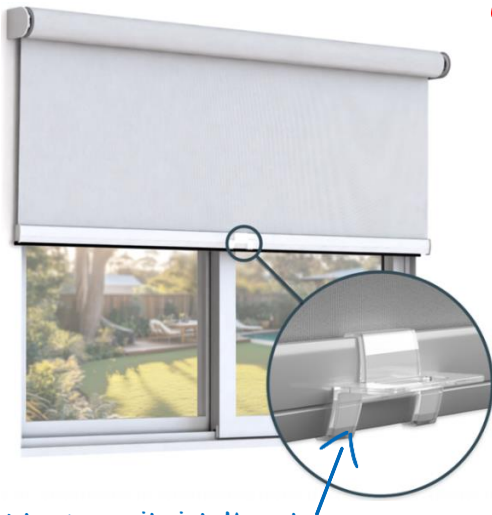
*"Why? Why do I need this? What makes is this so special?" "Where did I put my glasses?"*

## Breaking CBC News

Before we get into the nitty gritty of fabric releases slash discontinued ranges, we have an important message to pass on. Currently, the Easy Spring Air (ESA) is listed as a one size fits all \$cost to our customers regardless of widths.

However, in reality, there are actually 6 sizes that we use to suit the width, drop and fabric to ensure the blind runs smoothly - Micro, Mini, Small, Light, Medium and Heavy. So, we have re-assessed the material costs and have priced the different sizes accordingly.

We now have included an ESA Calculator tab in the Fabric Selection file so you will know exactly which size is required for the roller blind to be made.

Just select the fabric you would like in the drop down menu and the matching chart will appear with pricing.

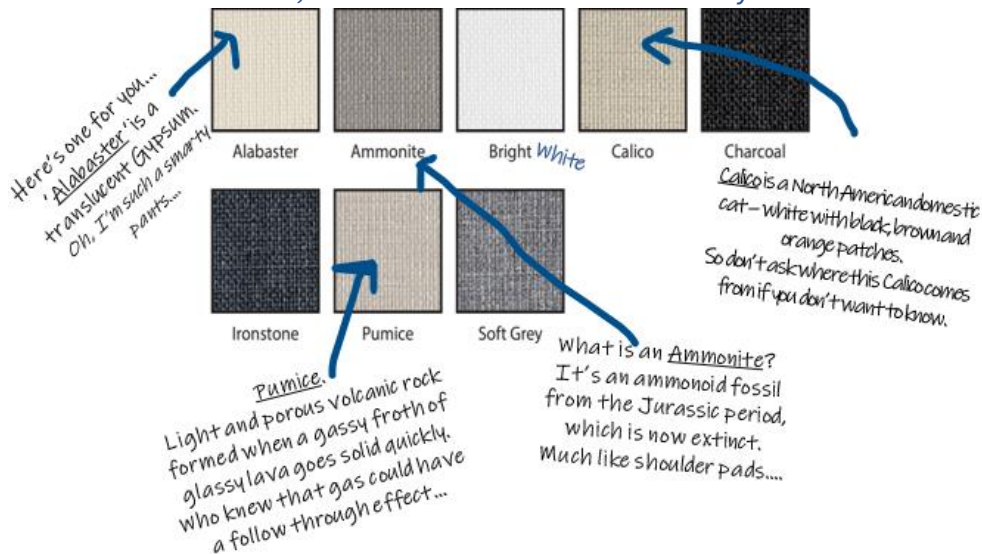

As of April 2025, the Dawn fabric will be showcasing 33 colours with some additions and some being retired (but still open to part time work if stock is available).

The newcomers are **Birch, Angora, Pannacotta, Ecru, Gosling, Daybreak and Thunder**  
Phasing out – Beige, Bison, Caviar, Macchiato, Nutmeg City Limits, Pebble, Royal Blue, Shale and Taupe



Like the Dawn above, the Uniview range (2%, 5%, 10% screen) has new colours included in the range, while some have had the locks changed on them.

New family members - **Bright White, Marble, Zinc, Granite, Steel**

In sad news, we have to let you know that the fabulous Bond vertical fabric and ALL Vertex vertical fabrics can only be used in the 127mm vertical blinds. Unfortunately, cutting these fabrics to the smaller blade sizes are compromising the quality of the blades - rough edges, wavy cuts, this does not make a good product for your client base..... So take note: Four Families Bond range and ALL Vertex vertical fabrics will only be made in the 127mm vertical blind size. Hopefully, the quality will improve in the near future and we can bring these back into the fold...
